a. **MOTION** recommending modifications to the Palms Slow Streets network ahead of the phase 2 implementation of the program DRAFT MOTION:

Whereas, the Palms slow street network during phase one consisted of:

- Keystone Avenue between Rose Avenue and Palms Boulevard
- Woodbine Street between Motor Avenue and Jasmine Avenue
- Mentone Avenue between Palms Boulevard and Venice Boulevard
- Tabor Street between Motor Avenue and Clarington Avenue
- Vinton Avenue between Palms Boulevard and Venice Boulevard
- Clarington Avenue between Palms Boulevard and Venice Boulevard
- Watseka Avenue between Exposition Boulevard and Venice Boulevard Resolved, that the Palms Neighborhood Council requests the following modifications to the Palms Slow Street network:
- The Clarington Avenue segment be removed from the Palms Slow Street network, and replaced with Dunn Drive, running between Venice Boulevard and its terminus north of Tabor Street
- The Tabor Street segment be extended, such that it runs from Motor Avenue to Dunn Drive
- b. **FUNDING MOTION**: To authorize up to \$1,000 to purchase lawn signs to promote Slow Streets phase 2 program

## IV. Adjournment
